Paper Bag Speech

Purpose: Getting to know each other

<u>Assignment</u>: Inside a paper lunch bag place three objects that symbolize three different parts of your life that are very important to you: family, future career, goals, friendship, religion, education, talents, etc. (your choice, but limit it to three). You may not use any pictures or photographs.

Outline of speech:

- 1. Introduce yourself
 - Name
 - How many siblings you have
 - Places you've lived or where you were born
- 2. Body of Speech: "In this bag are symbols I've chosen to represent three important parts of my life". (A symbol for each area is in the paper bag).

For each object in the bag:

- Pull out the object (symbol) and tell us what it is.
- Explain how it represents that area of your life.
- Explain why it (that area or part of your life) is important to you.
- 3. Close with a statement about why getting to know others in the class and sharing your values with them is important.

Extra Credit: Using any materials you would like, decorate the outside areas of the bag to give us more information about you:

- Likes/dislikes/hobbies
- Three words that describe you
- A career you are interested in
- Someone you admire
